Wey Valley Netball Club is firmly committed to creating and maintaining a safe and positive environment for all young people (anyone under 18 years) to play netball.

It accepts its responsibility to safeguard the welfare of all young people and protect them from poor practice, abuse and bullying. All clubs, associations & individuals are bound by the policies of England Netball, which relate to safeguarding and protecting young people in netball.

Therefore, at Wey Valley Netball Club we adhere to England Netball's Safeguarding policies, procedures and good practice guidelines.

All coaches are DBS (previously CRB) checked and attend training including Safeguarding and First Aid.

All suspicions and allegations of abuse will be taken seriously and responded to appropriately.

All coaches and volunteers have a responsibility to report concerns of abuse to the club's Safeguarding Officer.
